"The Joint Research Center's scientific support to the geospatial dimension of EU policies."

The contribution will first present the structure and organization of the European Commission and the role of the Joint Research Centers and Agencies distributed in Europe. Then, the talk will focus on the EU Joint Research Center in Ispra (VA) and on the scientific support and advice activities provided to the EU Commission, in particular presentation, visualization, analysis, interpretation, dissemination and creation of new standards for spatial data.

"Spatial Epidemiology in practice: John Snow's Cholera Map in digital form"

The workshop aims to reproduce one of the most cited examples of spatial analysis epidemiology: John Snow's cholera map of 1854. Using a widespread GIS software, QGIS, and the statistical software R, participants will assess the importance of spatial autocorrelation in statistical modeling and the role of distance in stochastic processes.

The seminar will be conducted in the framework of 'EU Back to University', that is an initiative whereby EU officials visit universities in their home country and share their personal experience of Europe with students.
